

GUIDELINES FOR THE OFFICIAL VISIT OF THE GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR

revised July 2011 for the 2011-2012 Grand Year

NOTES:

- Mother Advisors/Grand Deputies are to make copies of these guidelines and the "script" which follows. Feel free to "cut and paste" the script, inserting the Worthy Advisor's remarks in the appropriate places. You will want to avoid a situation wherein the Worthy Advisor must sort through several pieces of paper to accomplish each introduction at the Official Visit.
 - Prior to each Official Visit, the Supreme Inspector will provide the Grand Deputy (1) an Honorary Membership certificate which can be presented by the Assembly to the Grand Worthy Advisor; and (2) the current "email blast" listing. The Mother Advisor OR Grand Deputy should first email the invitation to the Supreme Inspector for "blasting" and then mail it **only** to those who are not on the "email blast" list.
- Prior to each Official Visit, the Supreme Inspector will email the Mother Advisor and Grand Deputy a current listing of dignitaries with appropriate titles to be used at the guest table as the Sign In Sheets. The Mother Advisor should ensure a highlighter pen is available for guests to highlight their names upon arrival. **BE sure to make time to transfer the highlighted** names on the sign in sheet to the podium copy of the script so the Worthy Advisor is not shuffling through papers to keep track of who she is introducing. *If you find corrections that need to be made, please advise the SI immediately; we don't want to perpetuate errors or over sights.*
- Please use this document as a guideline, adjusting it to fit the size of your Assembly membership, your Assembly Room, and the number of Assemblies hosting the Official Visit. Grand Officers are prepared to fill their stations at all times should you have a vacancy, *but often using visiting members from other assemblies makes younger girls feel important and needed.*
- **PLEASE ENSURE A TABLE IS AVAILABLE IN THE DINING AREA WHERE GRAND HOPE AND GRAND CHARITY – AND ASSEMBLIES – CAN DISPLAY THEIR SALES ITEMS – WE WILL MANEUVER A TIME DURING THE MEAL TO ALLOW EACH OF THE GIRLS TO MAKE HER SALES PITCH. NO OTHER SALES ANNOUNCEMENTS WILL BE MADE DURING THE OFFICIAL VISIT.**

ONE ASSEMBLY HOSTING AN OFFICIAL VISIT

Follow the basic outline, beginning on page 6)

TWO ASSEMBLIES HOSTING AN OFFICIAL VISIT

- The "Closing Assembly" Mother Advisor, Drill Leader and Musician enter. This Mother Advisor gives the "All persons...." ritualistic message and instructs the Drill Leader to invite the Officers of her Assembly (or both if there are not full corps of officers in each assembly) to enter the Assembly room.
- The "Closing Assembly" enters utilizing a normal march-in; the Mother Advisor instructs the Drill Leader to escort the Worthy Advisor to the East.
- The "Closing Assembly" Mother Advisor introduces her Worthy Advisor; the Worthy Advisor introduces her Mother Advisor.
- The "Closing Assembly" Worthy Advisor instructs her officers to assume their seats on the sidelines. The "Closing Assembly" Worthy Advisor will be seated in the East. The Drill Leader will be seated to the left of the seat which will be occupied by the "Opening Assembly" Drill Leader. ALL REMAIN STANDING UNTIL SEATED BY THE "OPENING ASSEMBLY" WORTHY ADVISOR.
- The "Opening Assembly" Mother Advisor and Drill Leader enter; this Mother Advisor DOES NOT GIVE the "All persons..." ritualistic message, but DOES instruct the Drill Leader to invite the Officers of her Assembly to enter the Assembly room.
- The "Opening Assembly" enters utilizing a normal march-in.
- The Flag Bearers enter with the flags and give their tributes.
- The Mother Advisor instructs the Drill Leader to escort the Worthy Advisor to the East.
- The "Opening Assembly" Mother Advisor introduces her Worthy Advisor; the Worthy Advisor introduces her Mother Advisor.
- The Worthy Advisor instructs her officers to assume their stations. The meeting is opened in ritualistic form.

OR

- All officers (and adults) can enter mixing the girls who will fill stations from each office; where girls are available from both Assemblies for the same office, the "closing" assembly officer will be seated in a reserved section of the Assembly Room until it is time for her to assume her station and the "opening" assembly officer will trade places with her.
- This is probably the more efficient and effective method; typically we are sharing an Official Visit because of Assembly size, not lack of calendar space.

Officers from the "Opening Assembly" are responsible for introductions through the Grand Executive Board, Grand Assembly Committee, and Grand Deputies (see notation in script). When the "Opening Assembly" Drill Leader returns to her station she remains standing. The "Opening Assembly" Worthy Advisor will rap 2 times, raising the officers of her Assembly AND those of the "Closing Assembly" and instructs: "The Officers of _____ Assembly # ____ will retire to the sidelines; the Officers of _____ Assembly # ____ will assume their stations."

The "Closing Assembly" Worthy Advisor will assume her station and seat the Officers. She and her Drill Leader will resume formal escort.

FOLLOWING FORMAL ESCORT, THE INTRODUCTION OF EACH ASSEMBLIES' MEMBERS AND ADVISORY BOARD SHOULD BE DONE BY ITS WORTHY ADVISOR, WITH THE PRESIDING WORTHY ADVISOR BEGINNING, THEN ASKING THE "OPENING ASSEMBLY" WORTHY ADVISOR TO DO THE SAME.

LIKEWISE, HONORARY MEMBERSHIPS, WHEN GIVEN, MAY BE GIVEN IN THIS ORDER.

SKITS AND PRESENTATIONS, IF DONE INDIVIDUALLY BY EACH ASSEMBLY, MAY ALSO BE ACCOMPLISHED IN THIS ORDER. HOWEVER, when more than one Assembly is hosting the Official Visit, it is appropriate for the Officers of each to work cooperatively when planning the overall visit, including participating jointly in the skit and presentations. **We do, to the extent possible, want to stay within a two-hour time-frame.**

OFFICIAL VISIT *2011-2012 SCRIPT, REVISED July 2011*

?The Mother Advisor/Grand Deputy should make (at least) the following copies of this document:

- one for the Worthy Advisor (to work with as she prepares) and
- one for the Drill Leader (to become familiar with prior to practice).

?After the Worthy Advisor has “settled” on her introductions, give her a clean copy so she can type or print her “introductory comments” on the script or help her do the data entry so she ends up with an entirely clean and ready document, with the exception of highlighting the names of those visiting. Space has intentionally been left in this script so the Worthy Advisor can add her introductory comments or the names of guests to this document to avoid working from multiple sets of papers at the podium. **BE SURE TO PAGINATE this document basically so each new introduction starts a page;** in this way, if there are groups of people who are not present, IE the Worthy Grand Matron/Paton, that page can be pulled out of the script.

?The numbers in brackets correspond with the sign-in sheets provided to the hosting Mother Advisors/Grand Deputies by the Supreme Inspector.

?Mother Advisors/ Grand Deputies should assist the Worthy Advisor by transferring (or highlighting) names from the sign-in sheets to this script prior to Opening.

?Place the “finished” document in a small three ringed binder so the Worthy Advisor can just turn the pages, rather than fussing with stapled sets or loose pages all over the podium . . . just like the GWA does at Grand Assembly!

When the WA is practicing, be sure she understands the instruction from the WA and that she just needs to follow them. She will need to practice - not just look at - the script several times before the Official Visit - be sure she is prepared sufficiently early that she has several days to go over this. She will be more comfortable with her task and therefore perform much better....and have a better experience!

Introduction of Rainbow Members should be their FIRST and LAST name; it is not necessary to say "Miss..."

Introduction of adults should be "Mr./Mrs./Ms./Miss FIRST and LAST name. Please remind both the Drill Leader and the WA that most of our Rainbow adults are MRS... not MS... but those who are indeed Miss - want to be called "Miss."

The Worthy Advisor and Drill Leader say "It is my **honor** to present (or introduce) if the guest will receive **Supreme or Grand Honors**.

The Worthy Advisor and Drill Leader say "It is my **pleasure** to present (or introduce) if the guest will receive the **Sign of the Rainbow**.

Most guests are introduced by their **current Rainbow title**, followed when appropriate by a "past" title, i.e., Mother Advisor **or** Past Grand xxx. There is an exception, of course, for PGWA's who also have another current title. They are introduced as PGWA and, AGAIN for any current leadership titles they have. **Please avoid giving a list of titles as long as the WA's arm with each person** - ie, Grand Deputy of ____, Past Mother Advisor, Past Grand ____, and Past Worthy Advisor....

The Worthy Advisor must instruct the Drill Leader to present each set of dignitaries. The Drill Leader should visually scan the room to see if anyone stands before leaving her position. If no one rises, the Worthy Advisor will continue with the next introduction.

When several types of dignitaries are introduced as a group and one or more specific title of dignitary is not present, that title may be eliminated after the Worthy Advisor announces it the first time. For instance, the Worthy Advisor will ask for "Past State Grand Deputies, Past Grand Deputies, and Grand Deputies Emeritus." If the Past State Grand Deputy is not present, and there are no Grand Deputies Emeritus present, only the remaining title is used thereafter by both the Worthy Advisor and Drill Leader, that is: Past Grand Deputies

If an officer is substituting for a station while an Assembly other than her own is presiding, at the time the officers change, she should stand with the raps of the gavel, stay in place, and be seated again as the officers are seated by the new presiding Worthy Advisor.

THE BASIC FORMAT FOR INTRODUCTIONS

WORTHY ADVISOR: "SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL PRESENT THE (title) FOR INTRODUCTION." If only one guest is escorted, the Drill Leader follows the line of march to the guest, bows to her, and extends her RIGHT hand to the guest. If multiple guests are escorted, she bows to the group; they follow her in single file. If escorting a large number of guests, or if those she has escorted are all from the North side of the room, **the Drill Leader will counter march behind the Bow so she will be at the North end of the line, once the guests are in line. The Drill Leader never walks in front of a partial line of guests to assume her position, nor does she present people from the south side of the line;** she should proceed to the North end of the line by walking behind the guests already in position. All guests are presented behind the Bow -- except current or past Supreme Inspectors or Members of the House of Gold, who are always presented behind the Altar.

DRILL LEADER: "WORTHY ADVISOR, IT MY HONOR TO PRESENT (title) . The Drill Leader does not say "in Nevada, etc." The Drill Leader takes one step back until she is addressed by the Worthy Advisor again.

WORTHY ADVISOR: *(Extends a greeting to the guest. Try to avoid phrases like "you are the elephant in our circus" and rather just a couple sentences about the theme or storyline, rather than "you are" statements.)* "SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL ESCORT THE (title) TO THE EAST."

Rainbow Members and Majority Members introduced by a "girl" title (for example, Past Grand Drill Leader who has NO adult leadership title) are escorted to the right of the Worthy Advisor's station (Chaplain's side). Adults introduced as "adults" are escorted to the left of the Worthy Advisor (Mother Advisor's side). Typically the only adults introduced and escorted in Nevada are the Supreme Officer and the State Rainbow Dad group.

The Worthy Advisor raises the Assembly as the Drill Leader turns on the line of march toward the East (northwest or southwest corner. The Drill Leader stops at the line of march, near the East, allowing the guest(s) to face her; when both are facing each other, the Drill Leader bows to the person(s) she has escorted. The Drill Leader joins the Members in giving honors to the guests.

The Grandies should be singing their "song" when the Assembly is "rapped up" and while the Drill Leader and the guest(s) approach the East.

"IT IS MY HONOR TO INTRODUCE (guest's name) , (title) , IN NEVADA, INTERNATIONAL ORDER OF THE RAINBOW FOR GIRLS. PLEASE GREET OUR (title – or guest) WITH (GRAND HONORS) AND A _____ WELCOME."
If the guest remains in the East, the Assembly is seated and the WA gives the next direction to the Drill Leader.

OR

WORTHY ADVISOR: "SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL ESCORT OUR GUEST TO HER SEAT." If the guest(s) is to be returned to her seat, the Drill Leader follows that instruction and then remains at that point (or at a typical "pause" position near the Observers) in the line of march if there are additional escorts. She does not need to return to her station to receive the next instruction provided she is in a typical west pause position.

The Drill Leader bows to each single guest (or to the last to be seated when she is escorting a group of guests). The Drill Leader does not bow to those who remain in the East.

SCRIPT

THE MOTHER ADVISOR, DRILL LEADER AND MUSICIAN ENTER in normal form.

Start WITH RITUALISTIC OPENING MAKING THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATIONS to the discussion with the Confidential/Outer Observers.

WORTHY ADVISOR

SISTER CONFIDENTIAL OBSERVER..... THE DOORS ARE NOW TO BE CLOSED FOR THE OFFICIAL VISIT OF THE GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR
Continue with ritual charge...

The CONFIDENTIAL OBSERVER repeats the same instructions to the Outer Observer and returns to her station; the Worthy Advisor continues with:

[1] **WORTHY ADVISOR**

The Worthy Advisor is encouraged to add here several sentences which will set the stage for the introductions to follow. For example, if the theme of the day is a circus, she would welcome everyone to the circus complete with popcorn, cotton candy, etc.....

SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL PRESENT THE GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR FOR INTRODUCTION.

DRILL LEADER

WORTHY ADVISOR, IT IS MY HONOR TO PRESENT THE GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR.
[The Drill Leader steps back each time she is finished with this presentation.]

WORTHY ADVISOR

(introductory remarks....to set the stage for the theme of escort....)

SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL ESCORT THE GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR TO THE EAST.



[The Drill Leader steps forward, even with the guest, when she is addressed and escorts the guest to the East . The Worthy Advisor gives three raps to raise the Assembly as the Drill Leader and the Grand Worthy Advisor turn the corner toward the East.]

WORTHY ADVISOR

IT IS MY HONOR TO INTRODUCE Miss Katherine Kirk,
GRAND WORTHY ADVISOR IN NEVADA, INTERNATIONAL ORDER OF THE
RAINBOW FOR GIRLS. PLEASE JOIN ME IN SALUTING OUR GRAND WORTHY
ADVISOR WITH GRAND HONORS AND A _____ WELCOME.

*[The Drill Leader REMAINS in the East and the Assembly REMAINS standing. Continue with ritualistic opening ... presentation of flag follows immediately. **DO NOT SEAT THE ASSEMBLY.**]*

WORTHY ADVISOR

SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL PRESENT OUR FLAG IN THE EAST.

[2] WORTHY ADVISOR

FORMAL ESCORT



(soft rap of the gavel).

SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL PRESENT THE SUPREME FAITH AND SUPREME INSPECTOR FOR INTRODUCTION. (BEHIND THE ALTAR)

DRILL LEADER

WORTHY ADVISOR, IT IS MY HONOR TO PRESENT THE SUPREME FAITH AND SUPREME INSPECTOR.

WORTHY ADVISOR

(introductory remarks)

SISTER DRILL LEADER, YOU WILL ESCORT THE SUPREME FAITH AND SUPREME INSPECTOR TO THE EAST.

[Worthy Advisor gives 3 raps to raise the Assembly as the Drill Leader and guest turn the corner (on Hope's side) toward the East. The Grand Officers will sing their song while the guest is being escorted to the East.]



IT IS MY HONOR TO INTRODUCE Mrs. Joanie Jacka, SUPREME FAITH AND SUPREME INSPECTOR IN NEVADA, INTERNATIONAL ORDER OF THE RAINBOW FOR GIRLS. PLEASE GREET OUR SUPREME FAITH AND SUPREME INSPECTOR WITH SUPREME HONORS AND A

WELCOME.

(The Supreme Inspector remains in the East. The Drill Leader stays near her station, standing, waiting for the next instruction.)

[Worthy Advisor gives 3 raps to raise the Assembly as the Drill Leader and guest turn the corner toward the East. The Grand Officers will sing their song while the guest is being escorted to the East.]
