## DEMIT

A Demit is a transaction which allows a girl to leave an Assembly in good standing; when she moves to a new geographic area, she should present it to the adult leadership and ask for a [Petition for Affiliation](#).

- Issued by the Assembly the member is leaving;
- Mailed, or hand carried by the member, to the Mother Advisor of the Assembly the member wishes to join
- The Mother Advisor (from either Assembly) should assist the member in completing a Petition for Affiliation
- Mother Advisors in Nevada will attach a personal, positive letter to the new Mother Advisor noting the
  - date the member was initiated;
  - dates she was awarded her Merit Bars, etc.;
  - offices she held;
  - honors she has receive, i.e., perfect attendance, Grand Cross of Color, etc.

\*When issuing a Demit, be sure to affix the Assembly's seal after the Worthy Advisor, Recorder and Mother Advisor have signed it.

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**Rating Guide**

NOTE: A copy of this form is to be distributed to each voting Board Member for each eligible Officer. The Grand Deputy will tally and average the ratings. The Grand Deputy will write the averaged ratings on the appropriate Grand Appointment form and forward it to the Supreme Officer. The Grand Deputy will destroy the ballots at the conclusion of the Board Meeting.

- **RITUALISTIC PERFORMANCE:** A rating of "5" reflects letter perfect ritualistic performance by this officer given reasonable notice to fill an office. As members progress through the Line, it is expected they will memorize their work and present it in an near-perfect manner. Reality reminds us, however, that not everyone has a photographic memory.
- **FLOOR WORK:** A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who has obviously attended practices and paid attention, even when other officers were performing. She is now able to accomplish any officer's floor work with ease and comfort.
- **COOPERATION:** A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who makes herself available to assist equally with "important" and menial tasks. A "5" indicates this Officer assists by filling vacancies - and - washing dishes!
- **DEPENDABILITY:** A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who signs up for an activity and then shows up, on time, at the appointed place, without several reminders. It also reflects an Officer who says "I'll get back to you...." and DOES.
- **ATTITUDE:** A rating of "5" reflects an Officer who cheerfully and graciously cooperates and demonstrates dependability. A high rating her indicates this Officer always has her "Rainbow Smile" on an projects encouragement, humility, kindness and consideration to all others.

### NOTICE OF ELECTIONS

- Completed and mailed by Recorder and Mother Advisor **immediately** following balloting;
- A personal note should be attached by either the Recorder or the Mother Advisor reinforcing the date and time the candidate should be at the Temple for her initiation. **This form does not provide for the time of Initiation.**
- Because the candidate submitted her initiation fees and annual dues with her petition, be sure to mark this area "N/A" (not applicable.)
- When issuing the Notice of Elections, be sure to affix the Assembly's seal after the Recorder and Mother Advisor have signed it.

### PETITION FOR AFFILIATION

- Completed by a member in good standing who desires to transfer her membership from one Assembly to another (usually because her family relocated).
- Should be attached to a completed Demit from the member's former Assembly.
- Read by the Advisory Board and Assembly, following the procedures for Petitions for Membership.
- Balloted upon by Assembly members.
- The Affiliation Ceremony will be held for the new member.
- Retention: File this document and the new member's Demit in the Assembly records with Petitions for Membership, indefinitely.

NOTE: The Mother Advisor will send a letter to the new member's former Mother Advisor indicating the date she affiliated. If information regarding the member's initiation date, merit bars, offices held, honors received, etc. has not been previously provided by the "old" Assembly, this is a good opportunity to again ask for this information.

Changes regarding this member's membership should be made immediately on the Supreme Annual Report - electronically. The Assembly/jurisdiction she came from should be helpful in providing their part of such transfer entries.

### PETITION FOR MEMBERSHIP

(back side of [Petition for Affiliation](#))

- Must be completely filled out.
- Must be retained indefinitely in the Assembly's records
  - (1) Must be signed by each member of the Visitation Committee;
  - (2) Leave blank if the Petitioner was found worthy by the Visitation Committee.

## PETITION FOR THE DEGREES

Petitions must be completed by the petitioner and her family. Petitions which are not complete are not yet ready for review and action by either the Board or the Assembly. Additionally Initiation fees/dues must accompany each petition.

When reading a petition, the Recorder will read the petition beginning at "To the Officers and Members" THROUGH the statement "My parents have no objection...."

The section which discusses church membership is not read at the Assembly meeting.

If the petitioner's parents belong to a Masonic Group, that information is read; if it is blank, no reference is made to it.

The recorder continues to read the petition. The application should be signed by two members in good standing of the Assembly, as well as a member of a Lodge or Eastern Star Chapter. If the petitioner's parents are Masonically affiliated, they may sign the petition.

### **Procedure**

Applications for scholarships must be submitted to the member's Advisory Board by May 1. The Advisory Board will review and forward all completed forms to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee, with their recommendation, by June 1.

### **Eligibility**

- Rainbow Members in good standing who are either graduating from high school this year or who are enrolled at an accredited institution. (Credits earned at a community college or other learning institution must be acceptable at an accredited college. Enrollment in a community or junior college is acceptable; however trade school enrollment does not qualify.)
- Majority Members for scholarships available specifically to them, i.e. the June Davidek Memorial Scholarship; the Margaret Kofoed Memorial Scholarship, the Supreme Inspector's Scholarship.

### **Application Package must include three sets of the following information:**

- Three written recommendations: one from a high school official (teacher, counselor, coach); one from a person within the community familiar with the applicant (Pastor, community leader); and one from the Advisory Board. When a Majority Member is unable to obtain a teacher's recommendation or that of her advisory board because of the time since her majority, two letters are sufficient.
- The applicant must indicate her need for financial assistance at this time.
- The applicant's most recent transcript (high school or college)
- The applicant's statement noting her intention to carry at least twelve (12) credits during each of the next two semesters.

**Initial distribution of funds:** One-half (½) of the total award will be issued upon receipt by the Supreme Inspector of a paid registration notice for the first semester.

To maintain eligibility for the second semester, each recipient must provide the Supreme Inspector with

- A transcript reflecting at least a 2.75 GPA for the semester
- Paid registration receipt for the second semester reflecting enrollment in at least twelve (12) credits during the second semester.
- Affirmation she has remained unmarried, if an active Rainbow Member.
- Affirmation of her continued commitment to personal conduct which is significant of a Rainbow member.

If scholarship funds are awarded and the student drops out of school during the course of EITHER semester, the funds for that semester must be returned to Nevada Grand Assembly through the Supreme Inspector.

Potentially EIGHT Personal Pages for the \_\_\_\_ Grand Year will be announced at the last fall Official Visit (date and location). These girls will be selected through an application/recommendation process by the Grand Line Officers and others who are assigned a Personal Page for Grand Assembly. The Page to Sound will “bond” with the Grand Musician and Grand Choir Director throughout the year. Pages to Sound, Grand Faith, Grand Recorder and others as needed will share responsibilities to the Sound Committee during Grand Sessions.

### Application Process

- This Personal Page Application is provided to Mother Advisors and Grand Deputies by email transmittal on **September 1, 2008**.
- Each Mother Advisor will copy and provide the complete application to girls who demonstrate an interest in one of these positions and who meet the minimum qualifications identified below.
- The Application Form must be completed by the applicant and signed by her parents as consent for her consideration, and a basic understanding of the expectations of the position, if selected, as well as the anticipated extra expense for Personal Pages at Grand Assembly \_\_\_\_.
- The Application Form must be returned to the Mother Advisor by **OCTOBER 10<sup>th</sup>**.
- The Mother Advisor will attach a simple letter of recommendation to the form and forward it to the Supreme Inspector **for receipt by OCTOBER 15<sup>th</sup>**. Advisory Board input and consideration, while helpful, is not mandatory.
- The Application Forms will be summarized by the Supreme Inspector and presented confidentially to the Grandies who will have Personal Pages; announcements will be made during the last weekend of fall Official Visits. *Girls who apply for Page positions MUST attend the \_\_\_\_\_ date and location of last fall Official Visit.*

### Expectations of Personal Pages

- Each Personal Page will “work” with the Grand Officer(s) she is assigned to during the balance of the year Grand to establish good communication and friendship.
- Personal Pages will attend all sessions of Grand Assembly **2009**, beginning with dress check and practice on Friday afternoon (approximately 1:00 pm) in **Las Vegas** through Grand Installation on Tuesday evening. Personal Pages will attend the Grandie Party on Friday evening as guests of the Grand Assembly Committee. This function includes dinner at no cost to the Grandies/Pages.
- Personal Pages must have shift-type short dresses for all practice sessions, just as the Grand Officers do (note - 2 short dresses/shifts work well....)
- Personal Pages will participate in all sessions by providing assistance with prompting, badge verification, “crowd” control, assisting with marching formations, props, etc.

- Each Personal Page will decorate a basket for her Grandie, present it to her (privately) at the GWA's reception in May (which is mandatory attendance for all Grand Officers and Personal Pages); the basket will be returned to the Page with something special just for her from her Grandie at Grand Assembly. The basket will be used and judged at Grand Assembly. The basket remains the property of the Personal Pages. Dimensions for the page basket is limited to 14 x 14 inches (roughly if it is not a square basket).

### **Anticipated additional costs for Personal Pages**

In addition to the "normal" costs for attending Grand Assembly such as registration, housing and meals, Personal Pages can anticipate these costs:

- Housing on Friday night (one additional night). On Friday night, Pages will be housed together, 4 to each room; Mrs. Koscik is their chaperone until assembly adults arrive on Saturday.
- Practice luncheon for Saturday and Tuesday (typically \$7-10 each; details will be in the Registration Package).
- Personal Page dress (\$80). These dresses are designed by the GWA and sewn by the Grand Seamstress. Payment for Personal Page dresses is due to the Supreme Inspector on or before DECEMBER 1. Specific information regarding dresses will be provided in October to those girls (and their parents) selected.
